

PROCEEDINGS OF THE 11TH EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING OF DISTRICT MINERAL FOUNDATION (DMF), SUNDARGARH HELD ON 11.02.2020 AT 3:00 PM IN PRAGATI MANDAP, SUNDARGARH.

The 11th Executive Committee Meeting of District Mineral Foundation, Sundargarh was held on 11th February, 2020 at 5:00 PM in the Pragati Mandap, Sundargarh under the Chairmanship of Collector -cum-Chairperson and Managing Trustee, DMF, Sundargarh.

The list of members attended the meeting is attached to this proceeding at Annexure -I.

At the outset, the Collector-cum-Chairperson, Managing Trustee welcomed all the members of the Committee to the 11th Executive Committee Meeting of DMF, Sundargarh. He introduced the newly engaged Persons under various Expertisation in DMF Office in the Meetings and requested the Members to take help from them as per their expertisation as per need. Then, he asked the Chief Executive Officer, DMF, Sundargarh to brief about the collection of DMF funds, administrative approved amount of sanctioned projects and expenditure thereof.

The Chief Executive Officer, DMF, Sundargarh briefed on the action points of the proceedings of the last Executive Committee Meeting held on 09.08.2019, the copy of the proceedings of the said meeting has been sent to all concerned vide Memo No.499/DMF dt.07.09.2019. He intimated that a total sum of Rs.2039.90 Crore has been received; against which Rs.573.42 Crore has been expenditure till date i.e. as on 31.01.2020. He further stated that Rs.1883.37 Crore has been sanctioned towards total cumulative approved projects of 3568 nos. which have been taken up as per necessity and requirement on need basis. Collector instructed all the Executing Agencies to ensure to enhance the expenditure by the next meeting positively emphasizing more focus on following aspects on priority:

- Health
- Education
- Skill Development & Livelihood
- Sanitation
- Environment & Pollution Control

Then, after a threadbare discussion on Agenda points, the following decisions were taken;

1. The CEO, DMF intimated that Project Management Software through Mobile App and Internet is being developed for DMF projects which will be beneficial for monitoring, tracking and reporting of the progress/ status of the works to various forums by officials, which was discussed and approved.
2. The DEO and DWO will submit the list of Tube Wells as per requirement at the field to Project Director, DRDA, Sundargarh through the concerned RWS&S Divisions for revival/ new installation out of the funds available under CFC/SFC at Block/GP level and departmental allocation of RWS&S. It was also decided in the meeting to take up Dug Wells where Tube Well/ Bore Well are not success. As regard installation of water filters in Hostels and Schools, the proposal should be submitted to DMF Office for further course of action in the matter at the earliest, as the summer is already knocking the door. Similarly, the DEO requested for renovation of existing school buildings which are in worst conditions was discussed and allowed to take up under DMF. It was also decided to provide LPG Cylinder with Stoves to the Hostels to avoid use of wood for cooking purposes and to reduce pollution. The DEO also requested to provide required number of school buses for each OAV schools functioning in the district on hire basis till provision of hostel facilities for the OAVs.

3. EE, RWSS Sundargarh intimated that Mega Piped Water Supply projects are going in 08 blocks presently and will be covered to all areas of the district including every schools and institutions subsequently and hence stated that no further funds under DMF is required for the purpose. He also requested to drop the approved projects under DMF accordingly. Collector asked the EE, RWSS to submit the list of projects in writing which are required to be dropped for further course of action and intimation to Government.
4. Orissa Lift Irrigation Corporation (OLIC) informed the Committee that 68 nos. of projects are in tendering stage and shall be completed within 3 to 4 months. The Collector instructed EE,OLIC to submit more new projects to DMF Office within 2 weeks to improve the cropping pattern in the district. Similarly, the DM, OAIC was also asked to submit more and more lift irrigation proposals in this regard for approval by DMF.
5. CDM& PHO requested for providing of Dialysis Unit, CT Scan, MRI Machine, Central Testing Laboratory in the DDH, Sundargarh, so that the people of the district shall avail the benefit easily, which was discussed and approved to be taken up under DMF. However, a request letter should be moved by CDMO to Government for permission towards establishment of Testing Laboratory. Further, he impressed upon for provision of Maa Gruha and NRC in each and every Blocks of the district. Proposal should be submitted for manpower requirement for housekeeping and management of office establishment of such institutions and hospitals as well.
6. It was decided that all medical equipments to be purchased out of DMF funds shall be through OSMCL, which is approved Vendor for the purpose. Further, CDMO intimated that the engagement process of paramedics and Ambulance are in the end of the process. Further, it was decided unanimously for installation of Solar Water Heater in all Hospitals.
7. DFO, Rourkela intimated that as per instructions of Government in Forest & Environment Deptt., Odisha, Bhubaneswar, nursery shall be raised 10, 00,000 saplings each in 3 Forest Divisions i.e. Bonai, Rourkela and Sundargarh for free distribution to the people. The cost will be cup based and will be met out of DMF. Collector suggested for rising of 4,00,000 fruit bearing saplings in each division out of 10,00,000 target. Further, it was decided to take up urban plantations in the district as per requirement.
8. The DFO, Rourkela and Bonai submitted proposal for setting up of leaf plate cup making unit at Darjing & Laing village under Rourkela Forest Division and Jamudar village in Bonai Division which was discussed and approved . Collector asked the DFO, Rourkela to install Solar Fencing in his area immediately and to complete before monsoon.
9. DFO Rourkela requested for road connectivity from NH road to Deodhara Eco Tourism under DMF. After a discussion, he was asked to submit proposal followed with estimate to be executed through DFO, Rourkela. Further, as per proposal of DFO, Sundargarh, development of Forest Park and Theme Park shall be taken up near Sarafgarh Eco Tourism under DMF.
10. EE, Minor Irrigation requested to drop 6 nos. of approved projects due to non-feasibility. Collector instructed to submit in writing with reason about the same and to submit more project proposals under irrigation sector.
11. DSWO stated that LPG cylinders have been provided @ 1 no. to each AWC due to which the AW Centres are facing problem in refilling of empty cylinders. Accordingly, it was decided to provide one more cylinder to each AWCs. Further, the PD, DRDA, Sundargarh shall be requested to look into the matter regarding delivery of fill cylinders at AWC point looking the viability.
12. It was decided to provide 200 ml of flavoured milk and egg to each school children and pre-school children in AWCs as additional supplement of nutrition to reduce malnutrition.

13. The Collector instructed all departments to complete all the on going projects at the earliest. In this regard, funds shall be released as advance in three phases (30%, 40% and 30%) against the sanctioned amount on receipt of requisition from the concerned Department(s).
14. The collector instructed all the agencies to include 5 years maintenance clause in the scope of work in the case of road projects so as to ensure long term sustainability of the projects and benefit to the people, the cost of which should be included in the DPR of the relevant projects.
15. During discussion on the progress of road from Barsuan to Banka Bazar, it was decided to submit the revised proposal immediately by EE, R&B Rourkela Division having road width of 10 meters due to local demand and as there is heavy traffic due to movement of multi-axle vehicles.
16. EE, RWD, Rourkela requested for improvement of the road from instructed to further fund Gurundia-Sambalpur road under DMF, which will provide better inter-district connectivity on completion. Collector also asked the PD DRDA to provide the unconnected roads to provide better connectivity to each and every hamlets/ villages of the district.
17. It was decided that the projects like Health Infrastructures, Sub-Centre buildings, OAVs etc. shall be taken up under OMBADC henceforward. Accordingly project proposals should be submitted to the Authority Concerned principally for approval of the projects.
18. As per request of EE, RWD, Sundargarh, it was decided to take up some road projects under DMF looking into importance and necessity of the roads in Balisankara, Subdega, Bargaon, Tangarpali, Lephripara blocks etc.
19. Executive Engineer, PHED requested for execution of some tube well proposals in slum areas of Rourkela.
20. All PA, ITDAs of the district were instructed to submit project proposals within 7 Days for development of infrastructures in schools and hostels managed by ST & SC Dev. Deptt.
21. The list of projects which have been taken up due to priority have been approved in the meeting unanimously, as enclosed at Annexure -II .
22. It was emphasized on all the Members of the Executive Committee and District Level Officers of various Line departments to attend the meetings unfailingly so that each and every aspects of need relating to the district can be discussed and decision taken thereof.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair and the Participants.
